Purpose: WAC 192-120-010 is amended to provide that the department will no longer send by regular mail a claimant information booklet to every individual who files a claim for unemployment benefits. Instead, claimants will be emailed a notice providing a link to the handbook. If the department is unable to send the notice by email, it will be sent by regular mail. Hard copies of the booklet remain available upon request. The department will prominently display a link to the booklet on its website.

WAC 192-270-035 is amended to clarify that the timeframes for submitting a training plan and enrolling are based on the date of emailing or mailing the informational notice, rather than the claimant information booklet.
